Policewoman: Right! But we're here too, and
we're ready for them!

Policewoman: And I've got Cat and Kate.

thanks, kids!

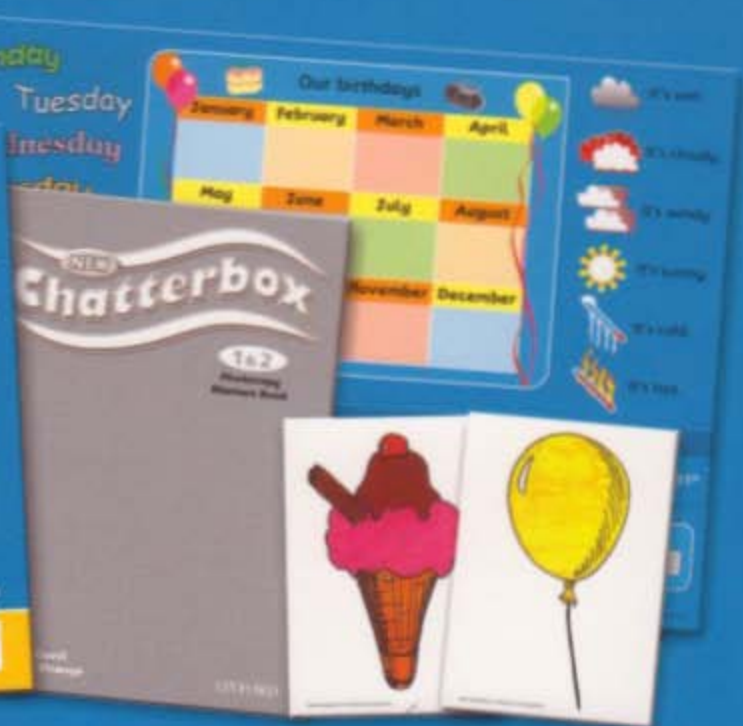
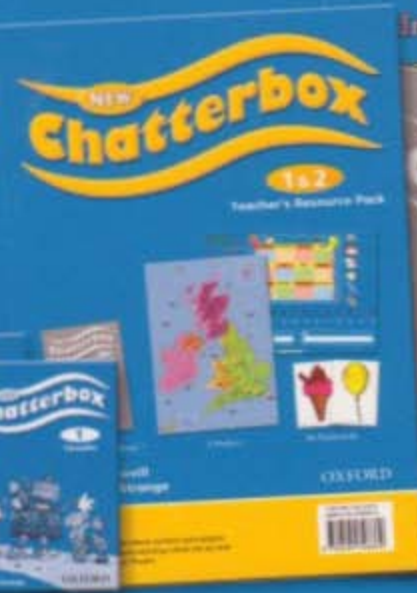


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
