On Sundays we visit my grandma and we play tennis in the park near her house. My brothers are very good at tennis and they usually win!

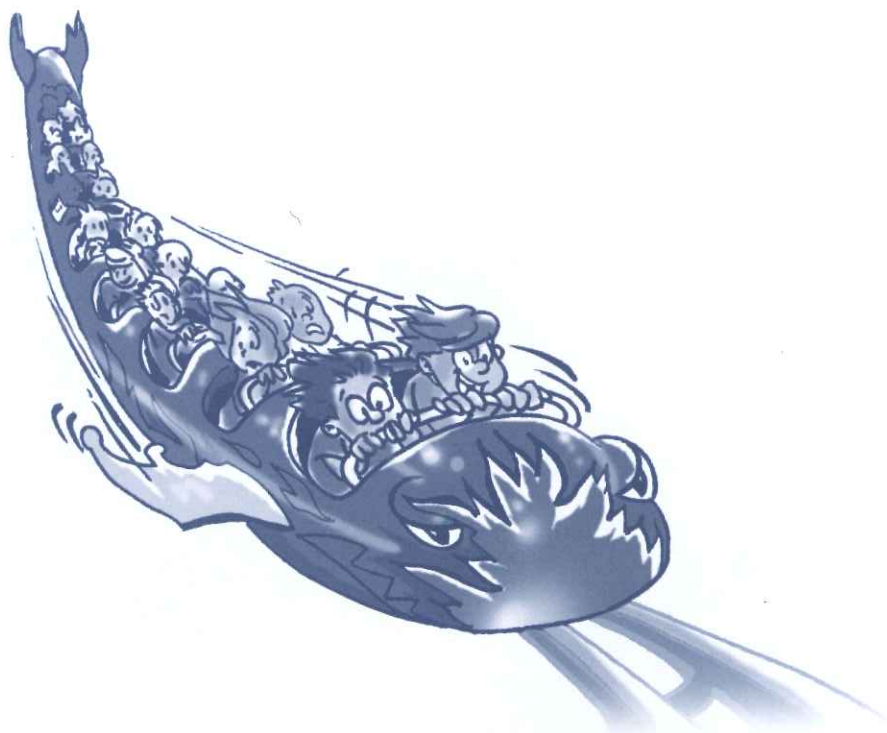
